

The WOMEN of Trentham in 1918



Martha Clay née Pitchford was born around 1868 in Acton, near Whitmore where her father was a waggoner.

She married Abraham Clay on 28th February 1888 at Newcastle under Lyme.

By 1901 they were living in Trentham , where Abraham was employed as a blacksmith on the Sutherland estate.

They had three children, two survived to adulthood.

The cottage where they lived is now 27, Longton Road.

Martha Clay was on the 1918 Register of Electors.
