Isabelle Wenger née Lovatt was born on April 27th 1880 in Didsbury, Manchester where her father was in the textile business.

In June 1902 she married Adolph Wenger of Wengers Ltd which produced colours for the ceramics industry and they lived on Sidmouth Avenue in Newcastle until 1911 when the couple moved to live at The Priory in Trentham.

They had four children and lived in Trentham for their rest of their lives. Members of the Wenger family still live locally.
