

# The WOMEN of Trentham in 1918



**Fanny Paget** née Martin was born in 1865 in Ramsbury, Wiltshire where her father was a bricklayer. William Paget was born in the village of Quenington, nearby and the couple married in 1886 and lived first in Southport and later Sandbach.

They moved to Trentham in 1901 when William got work on the Trentham estate as a groom and gardener. They lived with their three sons first in Earls Street and later Brough Lane.

Fanny's son, George was killed in WW1 and after the war, she went with her sister Ellen to visit his grave. She attended Trentham church where her son Frank sang in the choir.

Fanny Paget was on the 1918 Register of Electors.
